



CannaTrade 2010 General Conditions

1. Registration

Registration can only be accepted by using the forms provided by CannaTrade.ch AG. Confirmation of registration is on receipt of the invoice. The contract between CannaTrade.ch AG and the exhibitor becomes effective by sending out the invoice.

The management of CannaTrade.ch AG is authorized to decide on participation.

2. Conditions of payment

50% of the amount invoiced is due for payment within **20 days** from date of invoice. The remaining and additional costs have to be paid latest **30 days** pre-start CannaTrade 2010. The invoice has to be paid in **Swiss Francs** without discount to the banc account of CannaTrade.ch AG.

All fees for banc transfer have to be paid by the exhibitor. The setup as well as the issue of exhibitor tickets can only take place **after payment of the total amount invoiced.** The invoicing and payment of value-added-tax (VAT) is obligatory also to exhibitors from abroad. Costs for additional services ordered by the exhibitor are due for payment within 30 days from date of final revision.

The Swiss Code of Obligations applies particularly with reference to the right of retention.

3. Setup

Booths are assigned by CannaTrade.ch AG according to the 6 different categories. The booth plans may change due to hall-specific necessities. Hall pillars will be avoided to the extent possible, however they are considered as booth surface area.

4. Collective booths

Collective booths are permitted as long as a main exhibitor is responsible for **all concerns** and liable for all financial claims of CannaTrade.ch AG. Each sub-exhibitor will be entered to the catalogue and the homepage of CannaTrade by paying a fee of Sfr. 250.00 (VAT incl.). This fee and all additional services are directly invoiced to the sub-exhibitor. Conditions of payment are the same as for the main exhibitor.

5. Withdrawal

Any cancellation has to be effected **in writing** and must be confirmed **in writing** form by CannaTrade.ch AG. 50% of all costs remain due and payable for cancellations after 20th February, 2010. Cancellation is no longer possible after 15th March, 2010 and the total costs are due and payable. Work that has already been carried out remains due until payment. CannaTrade.ch AG is authorized to cancel the contract with immediate effect if the exhibitor does not comply with his payment obligations. **If the booth is not occupied by the exhibitor the night before the start of the exhibition (15.04.2010), CannaTrade.ch AG is authorized to dispose of the space at its sole discretion.** The exhibitor stays liable for the booth rental charges in this case. Costs for the re-adapting or decorating of the surface area are to the expense of the exhibitor. In case of sub-exhibitor's non-participation, the registration fees stay due and payable.

6. Cancellation / changes

CannaTrade.ch AG refuses any liability for cancellations and/or changes that cannot be influenced by CannaTrade.ch AG particularly in the case of Force Majored or due to government order. In case of cancellation, CannaTrade.ch AG claims 25% of the total amount requested. Changes of date and/or venue do not allow any reduction of claimed charges.

Due to changes of date or venue the exhibitor has the right to cancel the contract within 10 days.

7. Stand mantling and dismantling / technical data

The times of mantling and dismantling are specified in the technical documentation and have to be observed. Exhibitors with own booth systems please notice that the dimensions must be precisely specified, separating plates are required to delimitate booth spaces. You may order them also at CannaTrade.ch AG. Booth construction materials must comply with Swiss directives for exhibition booths. They may only be made of



robust, flameproof materials. Open flames are not permitted. The exhibitor is obligated to comply to all legal, fire, and safety directives and to comply with the hall rules.

8. Advertising

Advertising outside the booth requires explicit consent of CannaTrade.ch AG. Unauthorized advertising will be removed by CannaTrade.ch AG at the expense of the exhibitor. The distribution of promotional material is ONLY permitted in front of exhibitors own stands.

9. Electrical connections

The electrical connections will be mounted by CannaTrade.ch AG, the electrical load has not exceed the specified limit. The electrical distribution boxes in the hall need free access.

10. Security

The exhibitor is responsible for the supervision of his booth during the term of exhibition and the process of mantling and dismantling.

11. Clean up

The exhibitor is obliged to avoid improper disposal of garbage. Garbage bags are available for purchase. All exhibitor material must be removed after dismantling the booth.

Garbage not disposed of the exhibitor will be removed at the expense of him.

12. Rules

Exhibitor tickets are non-transferable. Food and drinks for direct consumption are prohibited to sell. Please use recyclable dishes to serve the purpose of degustation.

It is not permitted to remove the stand until the **end of the exhibition**.

13. Insurances and liabilities

The exhibitor is liable for personal and/or property damages caused by himself or his employees. CannaTrade.ch AG is liable only within the framework of legal determinations for damages caused by intent or gross negligence, including those inflicted by its personnel. The rules and regulations of MCH Messe Schweiz AG apply.

CannaTrade.ch AG recommends all exhibitors to take out an appropriate insurance.

14. Faults and complaints

Complaints and faults have to be reported immediately to the organizer so a prompt solution may be obtained. Claims are made 14 days afterwards the exhibition will not be considered.

15. Rules of the house

Instructions given by the staff of the hall management and the CannaTrade.ch AG have to be strictly observed. Otherwise the offending exhibitor might be excluded from the exhibition without refund of costs.

16. Jurisdiction

Court of jurisdiction is CH-3000 Bern, the headquarters of CannaTrade.ch AG.

The legally binding version of the present General Conditions is the one provided in German language.
